



TWFA 2022: The New 'Formes et Matières' Collection From Bains Guerbois



During a meeting with **Jean-Pierre Marois**, the founder of Bains Guerbois, at the TWFA summit in Cannes, we had the opportunity to discover the brand's new *Formes et Matières* collection in more detail.



Oud Laqué, signed by Mathieu Nardin, sublimates the mirror effects of the lacquered woods that populate the space, alternately "veined, shiny, warm, exotic and precious." This is a darker score, dressing a woody bed (guaiac, oud accord) with leather, dried fruits, and spices (davana, cardamom, clove). In this textured mysterious fragrance the oud wood



The new collection starts with two perfumes,
Damier and Oud Laqué. The first evokes the
giant checkerboard dancefloor where the
bathing fauna dances and sways. It's an
olfactory "black and white" opus by Fanny
Bal based on the contrast between black
pepper's explosive notes and sandalwood's
milky roundness. The aldehydes expand the
power of the top, and the cedar affirms a "dry,"
full-bodied sensation. In contrast, cashmeran
