MUTIS NUEVA GRANADA - KINTU

It's always a good thing to smell Mutis Nueva Granada. I find these bottles to die for, but also the scents inside are very intriguing, combining exotic notes and an elegant structure. The new one is no exception: Kintu. I remember it as a patchoulicentered composition, enhanced by the beautiful powers of Tolu Balsam, with all its ambery and spicy (cinnamon) facets. There is also Copaiba, a woody and balsamic note with touches of vanilla. Very heartwarming and enveloping.
