LUCIEN FERRERO CE N'EST PAS UN PATCHOULY

The treachery of images by Magritte inspires the lightest and loveliest airy woody fragrance!



The famous quip "ce n'est pas une pipe" (this is not a pipe) under a painting of a pipe, is inspiration for the name of Lucien Ferror's iconoclastic scent. We associate patchouli with either contemporary "fruitchoulis" where patchouli is clean and sanitised and sweet, or with earthy amalgams that vibrate low and deep. This is in contrast citrusy, fresh with a mint impression, and with a woody-resinous backdrop (and a gourmand dash of tonka) that never extends its invitation.
