"Ce N'est Pas Un Patchouly" translates to "It's Not Patchouli," but of course, Ce N'est Pas Un Patchouly actually smells primarily like patchouli.

Patchouli is not my favorite note in perfumery.

Of course, there are patchouli fragrances that I enjoy wearing: chocolate-woody Coromandel Chanel, chocolate-cardamom Borneo 1834 by Serge Lutens, and bitter lavender Patchouli Intense Nicolai Parfumeur Createur. But compared to the vast family of patchouli fragrances, this is very small group.

I tried Ce N'est Pas Un Patchouly without much hope, although I like the style pf Lucien Ferrero Maitre Parfumeur. I rarely like perfumes with solo patchouli. So it was a surprise to get a fourth patchouli fragrance, which I think is truly amazing.
